I am to forward herewith a copy of the reference cited for information and compliance of the directions therein which are reiterated below:

- a) If any poll has been conducted not more than two months prior to the date of poll of current election, in such cases, the Indelible Ink shall be marked on the middle finger instead of fore finger of the left hand. If ink has already been applied on fore finger as well as middle finger then the ink shall be applied on ring finger and so on.
- b) In case of missing finger rule 49 K of CER, 1961 shall continue to apply.
